





Make sure your entry is within 1-2 minutes

Speak into the camera, voice loud, clear and not too fast, know what you want to say

Avoid shaky movements, noisy space when filming (ie wind, traffic, dog barking, construction), filming into direct sunlight if filming outside, standing in front of a window to film



PROPS



Use props if this helps with your idea or invention explanation.

If you use a poster or picture as a prop, remember a picture can speak a thousand words - make sure it is readable on camera





- Film with a neutral background
- Make sure what you want is in the frame
- Plan your storyline <u>click here</u>
- Are you filming in one spot or many spots? Be clear on what you want to say in each spot, make position and narrative work together to tell an overall story
- Ask for feedback from your family and friends
